William A. Brown Jr., 40, of Bluefield, was found dead in his apartment Sunday.

An autopsy conducted by the state medical examiner's office in Charleston determined the death was due to natural causes.

He was employed at Andre's Restaurant in Bluefield.

Born in Hinton, he was the son of William A. and Mary Katherine Linkenhoker Brown of Hinton. He had lived most of his life in Hinton and was a member of the Ascension Episcopal Church there. He was a member of the Hinton Elk's Lodge and Kappa Sigma Fraternity.

In addition to his parents he is survived by one brother, James M. Brown of Beckley, and his maternal grandmother, Mary Linkenhoker of Hinton.

Funeral services will be conducted Thursday at 11 a.m. at the Ascension Episcopal Church with Vicar Griffin Callahan officiating. Burial will follow in Restwood Memorial Gardens in Hinton.
