James Dwayne McKinney, 20, died Thurs. Apr. 12, at Route 20, Lerona, following a car accident, according to state police Trooper J.E. Ratliff.

Born Dec. 30, 1969, at Hinton, he was the son of Roger McKinney of Kernersville, N.C., and Carolyn Brookman McKinney of Hilldale.

Mr. McKinney was a lifelong resident of Summers County, was a 1988 graduate of Hinton High School, was a sophomore at Concord College and attended the River Valley Baptist Church.

Other survivors include a sister, Angie McKinney at home; maternal grandparents, James and Clara Bryson of Hilldale; paternal grandmother, Joy Ann McKinney of Sandstone; maternal great-grandmother, Wanda Brookman of Hilldale and paternal great-grandmother, Lola McKinney of Rupert.

Services were held Sun. Apr. 15 at 2 p.m. at the River Valley Baptist Church on Forest Hill Road, with the Rev. Bill Jenkins officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park at Hinton.

The body was at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton and at the church one hour prior to the services.
