Kathryn Fulton Dies in Huntington

Mrs. Kathryn Elizabeth Fulton, born in Hinton 51 years ago, died at 6:35 p. m. Wednesday night at her home in Huntington after a long illness.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9 a. m. in St. Joseph's Catholic church Saturday and burial will be made in Woodmere cemetery.

A daughter of the late James F. and Maggie Smith, Mrs. Fulton was born in Hinton and had been a resident of Huntington for 34 years.
