Mrs. Walter Burton, Nee Miss Teresa Stout of this City, Died at Home in Matoaka; Funeral Services Tuesday.

Matoaka, W. Va., March 31 (AP)—
Mrs. Teresa Stout Burton, 37, wife of
W. G. Burton, Mercer county prose-
cuting attorney, died at her home
here today.

Word was received here early Mon-
day of the death of Mrs. Walter Bur-
ton, of Matoaka, who was formerly
Miss Teresa Stout, of this city. De-
tails regarding her death are un-
known, but death is said to have oc-
curred at 3 o'clock at her home in
Matoaka where she had been ill for
a short time.

Mrs. Burton is pleasantly remem-
bered in this city where she was well
and favorably known, and her host of
friends here will be grieved to learn
of her death. During her residence
in this city Mrs. Burton was a teach-
er in the Hinton public schools and
for many years was principal of the
Junior High School. She made her
home while here with the late Mrs.
S. P. Peck.

Funeral services were held Tues-
day.

Mrs. Burton is a cousin of Misses
Genesee and Mildred Sentz, of this
city, who attended the funeral and
