William O. ("Jack" or "Little Doc") Johnson passed away in his home in McHenry, MD on Saturday, November 18th.

Jack Johnson, the son of the late Dr. Jesse T. and Mary Della Johnson was born in Meadow Creek, WV on November 21, 1933 and was raised in Hinton, WV. After graduating high school, he joined the U.S. Army where he served as a paratrooper during the Korean War.

Mr. Johnson moved to Washington, D.C. in the 1950's where he met his wife, the late Jewell M. Johnson of Auckland, New Zealand. The couple settled in Montgomery County, MD in 1963. Ten years after his wife's death in 1983, Mr. Johnson retired from his career as a superintendent in the construction industry and moved to the town of McHenry in western Maryland. He resided there until his death.

Mr. Johnson is survived by his children Eleanor Johnson Brunner of New Milford, CT, Lionel William Johnson of Gaithersburg, MD, Heather Mary Johnson of Baltimore, MD, and his sister Jennie Lee Moomau of Rockville, MD.
