Mrs. Cynthia Ann Maddy Fredeking, 95, of Hinton, died Saturday, December 11, 1999, at the Summers Co. Appalachian Regional Hospital at Hinton, following a long illness.

Born February 16, 1904 in Summers Co., she was a daughter of the late B. Frank and Electra Woodrum Maddy, and was a lifelong resident of Summers Co.

Mrs. Fredeking was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Hinton where she was saved in April of 1923.
