Nancy Taylor Patrick, 62, of Hinton, died Saturday, May 1, 1999, in an area hospital following a short illness.

Born June 29, 1936, in Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Charles A. and Gladys Foster Taylor.

Mrs. Patrick worked for the judicial system, having retired from the Supreme Court of Appeal on Oct. 1, 1998. She worked part time in the Summers County Circuit Clerk's office until the time of her death.
