COOPER FUNERAL RITES WEDNESDAY

HINTON, Sept. 16 — Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p. m. Wednesday for Delmar Cooper, 29, a former resident of True, who died Sunday in a Baltimore hospital following a paralytic stroke, which he suffered on a Baltimore street Thursday.

He served for five years in the army, and had resided in Baltimore for 18 months.

He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jack Cooper, of True and a member of the Missionary Baptist church. Other survivors include three brothers: John Cooper, of Lancaster, Pa., Franklin and Dawson, of Baltimore; and two sisters: Mrs. Danese Farley, of True, and Mrs. Dean Cooper, of Baltimore.
