### **MANN SERVICES TO BE CONDUCTED AT 2 P.M. FRIDAY**

Funeral rites will be conducted at 2 p. m. Friday at the Hinton Methodist church for Mrs. Faye Mann, well known Hinton resident and wife of Emmett A. Mann, who died at 4:45 p.m. Wednesday in the Hinton Hospital.

The Rev. Ross Evans, Dr. Fred B. Wyand and the Rev. Harry V. Wheeler will officiate with burial in the Pisgah cemetery.

Mrs. Mann had been in ill health for the past year and her condition had been considered critical since last Friday.

Born at Hilldale, Summers county, she was a daughter of the late Slem and Josie Holstine Long and had lived all her life in Summers county where she formerly taught school.

Mrs. Mann was married April 2, 1912 and had resided in Hinton since 1919. She was a member of the Hinton Methodist church, Hinton Delphi club, Hinton Woman's club, Woman's Society of Christian Society, and the JOY class of the Methodist church.

Besides her husband, survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Granville Anderson Jr., of Hinton, Mrs. Hiter Milton of Huntington, and three grandchildren.

The body will remain at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors.
