Hinton Resident Dies In Hospital

HINTON (RNS) — C. Andrew Bowman, 61, of 405 James St., Hinton died at 10:25 a.m. Tuesday in a Beckley hospital, where he had been a patient for eight days.

Born in Hinton, Oct. 7, 1902, he was the son of the late Charles C. and Edna MaHanes Bowman.

He had lived his entire life in Hinton and was a retired automobile mechanic. He was a member of the Hinton Methodist Church, a World War II veteran and a member of the Hinton Masonic Lodge.

Survivors include a brother, Oswald of Connellsville, Pa.; and two sisters, Miss Frances Bowman of Hinton and Miss Gladys Bowman, warden at the Federal Reformatory for Women in Alderson.

The funeral will be conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton with the Rev. William Wise in charge. Burial will be in the Greenbrier Burial Park.

The body will remain at the funeral home.
