## Laid to Rest

Dr. Hill first graduated from the Hinton High School, then took the degree of A. B. from West Virginia University; and in June of 1906, graduated from the Medical Department of the University of Pennsylvania.

He was a Phi Sigma Knapp, Alpha Knapp and a member of Charles K. Mills' Neurological Society.

Dr, Hill was a highly respected young man, and his death has brought sorrow to his many friends and acquaintainces.
