CLEARWATER (By Staff Writer) — The Rev. Linden S. Dodson, 67, 1753 Greenlea Drive, died Tuesday in an area hospital. Born in Louisburg, W.Va., he came here in September from Dallas, Tex. He was a retired college professor from the University of Maryland and federal chaplain at Seagoville Federal Institution, Dallas. He was a member and minister of the United Church of Christ. He also was a member of the Dallas Ministerial Association, Phi Delta Theta of West Virginia, and the Masons. He received his bachelor's degree from Rutgers University, New York; his master's degree from Boston University, and his doctor's degree from the University of Chicago. Survivors include his widow Mrs. Mary Dodson; two sons, William S. Dodson, Quincy and Robert Dodson, Clearwater; three grandchildren; a brother, Vernon R. Dodson, Ashland, Ky.; and a sister, Mrs. I. Larkin Riggs, Eaton, N.C.
