Meredith A. Nicely, 92, formerly of Hinton, died in San Antonio, Texas on August 1, 1996. He was the son of the late Chalmers Edward Nicely and the late Minnie Mayes Nicely, he was born in Longdale, Virginia on July 15, 1904.

The family moved to Hinton when he was a small child. He played football for Hinton High School and graduated in 1923. After serving his apprenticeship in the C & O shops, he was employed as a machinist.

In 1931 he moved to the Washington D.C. area and was employed by the U. S. Navy Yard as a Master Machinist/ Supervisor from 1933 to 1963. He resided in Temple Hills, Maryland for 54 years through 1990.

He was married for 61 years to the former Addie Payne Nicely, also from Hinton, who preceded him in death in 1988.

Inducted into Hinton Lodge AF & AM, he was a life member of Camp Springs (Md.) Lodge No. 227 AF & AM, Past Patron of Marlboro (Md.) Chapter No. 61 OES, and a member of Southgate Lions Club and Henson Valley Christian Church.

Survivors include two daughters, Mary Patricia Kremer of Hilton Head Island, S.C. and Carolyn McKenzie Meyers of San Antonio, Texas, six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. A nephew, James E. Nicely resides in Hinton.
