Shrader Fatally Injured In Crash

HINTON — Marvin Jack Shrader Jr. of Jumping Branch Route near Beech Run was injured fatally Wednesday in a single-car accident about 300 feet north of the Hinton City Limits on W. Va. 20, according to a Hinton state Police report.

A passenger, Robert L. Martin Jr., 16, of Hinton is listed in satisfactory condition at Summers County Hospital.

Police said Shrader's car ran against a hillside on W. Va. 20, flipped over and came to rest on its top in the middle of the highway.

Shrader, 19, was pronounced dead on arrival at the Summers County Hospital.

Born Nov. 24, 1956, in Summers County, Shrader was a son of Marvin J. and Nancy Bolling Shrader of Beech Run.

He attended Hinton

schools and the Beech Run Baptist Church.

Other survivors include one brother, Mark, at home; two sisters, Mrs. Debra Cantrell of Athens and Mary Pat Shrader, at home, and the maternal grandparents, Gilbert and Opal Hogan Bolling of Hinton.
