BALLENGEE RITES SET FOR TUESDAY

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors for George B. Ballengee, 63, of Buck who died Sunday afternoon in the Hinton Hospital after a long illness.

The Rev. Ralph Malcomb will have charge of the service with burial in the Bennett family cemetery at Pluto.

Born June 15, 1898 in Raleigh County near Pluto, Ballengee was a son of the late Henry and Mary Richmond Ballengee.

He had resided in Summers County for 43 years and before his retirement worked at the Hinton Hospital for 13 years. He was a member of the Low Gap Methodist church.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Nellie Carson Ballengee; a stepson, James Carson, address unknown; two brothers Thomas Ballengee of Pluto and Herman Ballengee of Buck; two half brothers, Walter Ballengee of Hinton and James Ballengee of Judson; a half sister, Mrs. Mary Meadows and his step-mother, Mrs. Frances Ballengee of Hinton.
