Former Boone County Attorney C. E. Hall Dies

HOMETOWN — Clarence E. Hall, 68, of Talcott died this morning in Summers County Hospital, apparently of a heart attack.

A native of Hinton, he lived in Boone County for 35 years where he practiced law and served two terms as prosecuting attorney. Employed in the West Virginia Department of Finance, he retired in 1971. A veteran of World War II, he was a member of the Community Church at Pence Springs and of the Civil Air Patrol. He was a member of the American and West Virginia Bar Associations.
