Carrie O'Bryan Cook, 49, of 515 Third Ave., died 7:15 p.m. Mon., Jan. 25, 1993, in a Hinton hospital following a long illness.

Born Sept. 25, 1943, at Hix, she was the daughter of Robert L. O'Bryan of Hinton and the late Mazie Wheeler O'Bryan.

Mrs. Cook had lived most of her life in Summers County.

She was a member of Chestnut Grove Baptist Church and was employed by Dr. Steve Richman of Hinton.

She was preceded in death by two nephews, Dean and Dennis Richmond.

Survivors include a son, Jon and his wife, Sarah Cook of Hinton; a sister, Syble Richmond of Clayton; two brothers, Howard O'Bryan of Columbus, Oh. and Edward O'Bryan of Hinton and companion, Tom Plumley of Hinton.

Services were held at 2 p.m. Thurs. Jan. 28 at Elk Knob Baptist Church, with Pastors Eddie Johnson and Benny Allen officiating. Burial followed in the church cemetery.
